Vermont's Three ACOs

Community Health Accountable Care (CHAC)

 Primary care-based network of providers whose philosophy for caring for patients is built upon the Federally Qualified Health Center commitment to provide access to care to all who seek it.

Vermont Collaborative Physicians (VCP)

 HealthFirst's ACO whose network is made up of participating independent PCPs and specialists.
 VCP is wholly owned by HealthFirst.

OneCare Vermont (OCV or OneCare)

 ACO is owned and operated by UVMMC and Dartmouth and includes a large network of providers, hospitals and other agencies.



Expected Future State in VT (2018 & beyond)

Three ACOs combine to form VCO (VCO is currently fully formed as a Board and separate entity)



VCO contracted with OCV to administer the APW, currently only limited to VMNG in 2017, and plans for Medicare (Next Generation – i.e. risk) starting 2018. VCO administers All Payer Model (APM)



APM intended to be an incentive program that includes Medicare, Medicaid and Commercial Payers.
