	• PCP Assignment: Dr. Reiss explained how patients are assigned to primary care practices through patient selection under the exchange, based on insurance coverage, and through "rostering." He noted the challenges practices face when being evaluated for their care of patients they may have never, or only rarely, seen, which can happen for exchange patients and those assigned through rostering.
